Project Information Report for Hines Hill Road Reconstruction

You are receiving this notice because Hines Hill Road is scheduled for street reconstruction. We have provided some information below that you may find helpful, to answer your initial questions:

Project Limits: Boston Heights West Corporation Limit to Olde Eight Road (5,640 LF)

Total Project Cost: \$ 1.3M

Major Project Components:

- ✓ Section #1 (West Corporation Limit to Wooded View)
 - Full depth street reconstruction, widening, ditch improvements, and asphalt pavement
- ✓ Section #2 (Wooded View to Olde Eight)
 - Full depth street reconstruction, widening, curb & gutter, asphalt pavement, and storm sewers

Project Schedule:

- ✓ Section #1 to begin in September 2013
- ✓ Section #2 to begin in October 2013
 - Work will continue, weather permitting, through November. Any work which remains will be completed in the spring of 2014.

Traffic, Access, & Detours:

- ✓ Thru Traffic will be detoured during construction of Section #1 and Section #2 (See map on reverse)
- ✓ Local Traffic will be maintained at all times, but short term delays can be expected with certain types of construction operations, so give yourself some extra time and be patient with the flaggers.
- ✓ Mail delivery and garbage collection will be maintained during construction.
- ✓ Police, Fire, and School Bus Access will be maintained during construction.

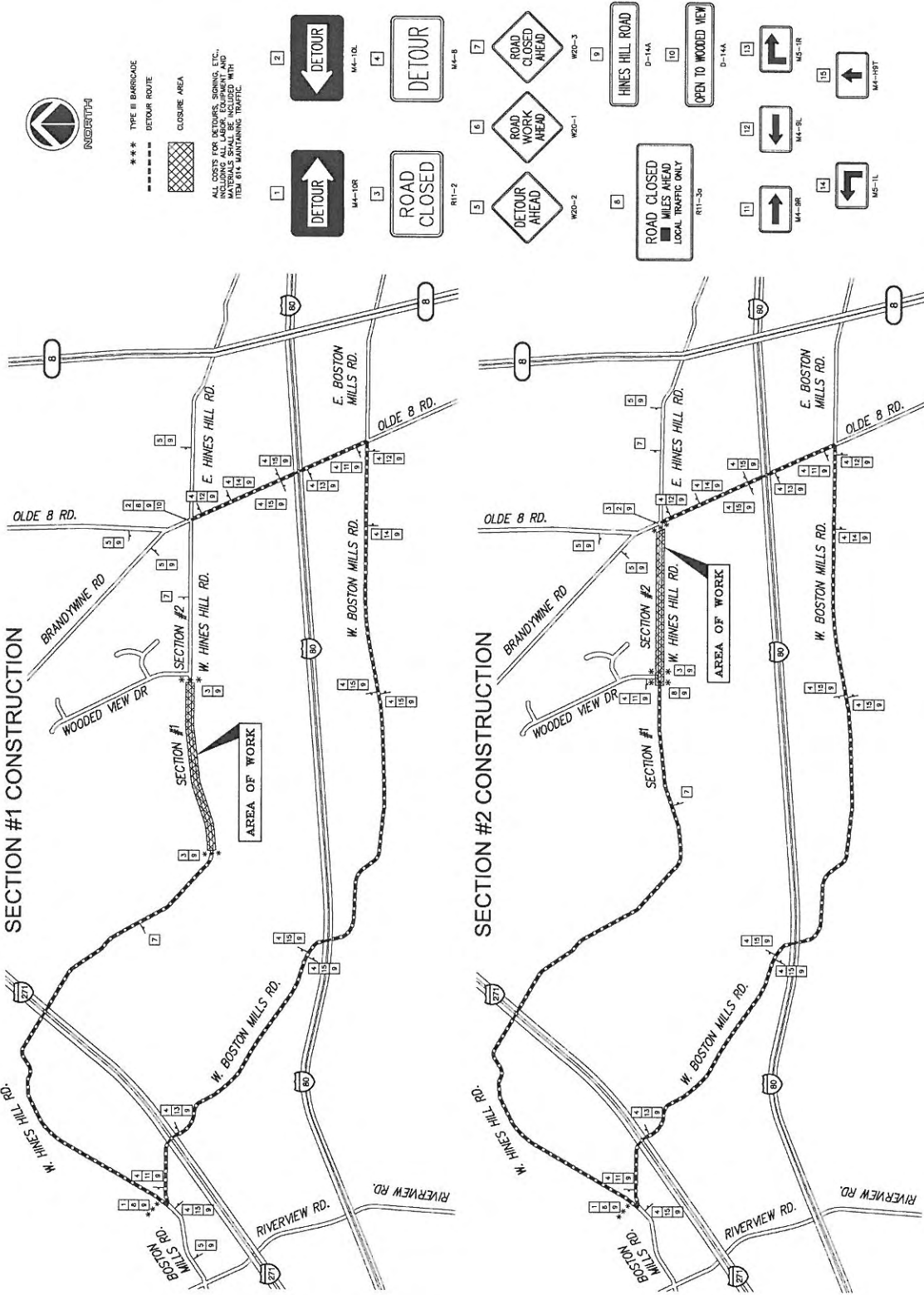
General Conditions:

- ✓ All construction projects involve dust, mud and equipment noise during the work hours. However, we will work with the contractor to keep the work area clean and safe at all times.
- ✓ The contractor will exercise caution around all buried utility lines, but temporary disruptions in utility services can occur, if the contractor disturbs existing facilities. Report outages to the utility company.
- ✓ Use caution around construction equipment and keep children a safe distance from the work zone.
- ✓ At the end of the project, the Village will make sure that all areas disturbed by construction are returned to their pre-construction condition or better.

Project Communication:

- ✓ Construction Schedules, Work Activities, and Work Areas are subject to change according to weather, materials, or issues on the project. We will communicate on the project in the following formats:
