Some residents have inquired about open burning in the village. Small fires in outdoor grills, metal and masonry fireplaces and in clay pottery or metal outdoor chimneys is permitted. Our Fire Chief also says Ohio allows open fires about 3 to 4 foot in diameter and about 4 foot high without a permit.

The Route 30 paving and paint stripping in the Village is completed. The ODOT contractor needs to finish the guardrail.

Brandywine Road and Wolcott Drive have been paved and the park drive paved and the parking lot was chip and sealed. Roadway paint stripping on main roads has been completed.

The last planned branch pickup is scheduled for the week of October 6<sup>th</sup>. Leaf pickup will follow as needed and dates will be posted on the Village Hall signboard.

***Council Meeting, August 13, 2008***

ORDINANCE #9, Legislation amends the codified ordinances of the Village of Boston Heights concerning operation and maintenance of Fairview Cemetery.

RESOLUTION #23, ODOT compensates [\$22,879] to the Village for loss of revenue from a gas well eliminated by the frontage road creation right-of-way.

A Motion approved the Financial Statement for June 2008.

***Council Meeting, September 10, 2008***

ORDINANCE #10, implements the establishment and description of the boundaries of the village Community Reinvestment Area, designates a housing officer and a housing council. Ordinance #10 of 2008 replaces Ordinances 19, 20 & 21 of 2007.

RESOLUTION #24, Authorizes the Fire Chief to assign members of the fire department for special detail for the maintenance of village fire equipment.

By a Motion, the July 2008 Financial Statement was approved.

Both the Planning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals meetings were cancelled due to lack of items for either agenda.
